

It has been more than two decades since Iran joined the international treaties deriving from the 1992 Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro. Unfortunately, despite the explicit nature of those treaties, emphasis is placed on the bottom-up approach and the participation of people and civil society, including NGOs, and at various meetings the treaties also hold status for NGOs, but because of weak capacities and The lack of knowledge of NGOs in the country, the number of NGOs, that have joined the treaties, and the number of NGOs, who are able to use international resources in these areas, are very limited.

In the first step of this project, the population of Land Sponsors intends to hold a workshop aimed at raising the level of awareness and knowledge needed in this project, while identifying NGOs active in the field of land degradation and climate change and interested organizations working in these areas. On the two Conventions on combat to Climate Change and Desertification.

To achieve this goal, a workshop was planned and implemented to achieve a framework for other workshops. Also two workshops were held with the main audience present.

The one-day workshop was attended by representatives of relevant organizations, representatives of NGOs, etc.

People attended the workshop facilitation team and the supporters of the earth's population, have attempted to develop future workshops.

The next workshop was held for 2 days with more than 50 NGOs, indigenous and local communities, NGO representatives, etc. in the JAVANSHIR Engineer Training Center.

The third workshop was held with more than 40 women active in the field of natural resources with the aim of raising awareness, sharing knowledge and also attracting them more on issues related to resilience and control of land degradation than educational and Share plans made by people with other members to make a broader scope of goals aware and impact their activities.

It should be noted that the project will continue on a wider scale in the future, and its objectives can be outlined below.

- Informing the community on land degradation and resilience issues;
- Upgrading the scientific and executive capacity of NGOs in the field of land degradation and resilience;
- Involve NGOs to work in the areas of land degradation and resilience;
